STSC is proud to represent **LENZING™**, who make a range of world-renowned cellulosic eco-yarns that are the highest accredited made in a closed-loop system from wood pulp that is sourced from sustainable forests (mostly eucalyptus and birch) which hold Europe's highest sustainable certification.

Woven fabrics include 100% Modal™, Modal™ and Linen blends, 100% Tencel™ and Tencel™ Denim plus Tencel™LUXE (ecocouture for luxury brands) and blends. We also wholesale their newest and most environmentally sustainable and biodegradable yarns, ECOVERO™ plus Jersey knits using 100% ECOVERO™ and blends.

Development for **Tencel™** ActiveWear, bed Linen, **REFIBRA™** and **LENZING™** FOOTWEAR is available by paid Consultancy service to develop and must meet MOQs.

As Lenzing produce the yarn, STSC have developed sustainable supply chains to create the finished eco-fabric. We have selected several commercial mills in India, Indonesia and Japan who use some of the most advanced production equipment including biological water waste and chemical treatment and conservation systems.

DYES. STSC also ensures that we only wholesale fabrics that use dyes that are non-AZO, OekoTex 100 Standard 100 or we can work with you to have it dyed with pure plant based dyed, or GOTS accredited low-toxic dyes. All Mills address our key concerns of water conservation, clean water preservation and minimal negative environmental impact in our supply chains.

STSC has also been been selected by Lenzing as one of their exclusive wholesalers to sell their new luxury product **Tencel™LUXE**. We are also proud to be working with eco-sericulture specialists who are a rural co-op who produce our organic Peace Silk. We are in the process of creating a unique range of luxury fabrics exclusive to STSC, using Tencel Luxe and Peace Silk blends, which we believe will be the world's most sustainable and ethical eco-couture fabrics.

These beautiful, ethically sourced Peace Silks are made from cocoons where the silk worms live in an organic environment and have been supported to evacuate as moths naturally and were not boiled alive. Additionally this silk is degummed without using chemicals as is the method used in making traditional silk.

STSC have worked carefully to create these supply chains and offers a wide range of fabrics, plus develop entirely new blends and gsms.

STSC are proud to be affiliated with Lenzing and wholesale only trademarked Lenzing yarn that is then turned into fabric to STSC's specifics with our accredited manufacturer to meet higher than regular sustainable standards along our entire supply chain, from the forest to the fabric. Fabric labelled as viscose, Lyocell or even illegal untrademarked Tencel, are coming from potentially unknown and unsustainable chemically made sources without care for the water or forests' rejuventation.

"This light and versatile material is a cellulosic fibre made by dissolving wood pulp, and it has exploded in popularity in recent years. As it is 50% more absorbent than cotton, its superior moisture-wicking and anti-bacterial properties make it ideal for use in activewear. Requiring less energy and water than cotton, Tencel is also biodegradable and according to Lenzing, sourced from sustainably managed eucalyptus plantations.

Although it does require petrochemicals in the production process, they are used in a closed-loop system meaning the same solvent is recycled time and time again to minimise harmful waste."

These cellulosic fabrics are biodegradable, uptake eco-dyes extremely well to save water, are breathable, long-lasting softness, hard wearing, versatile, and rate higher absorbency than other natural textiles. Lenzing grow and harvest from their own local, European accredited sustainable forests, then manufacture in a state-of-the-art closed loop system, this method produces yarn that satisfies 99% of the circular economy needs. STSC then take it to Mills in India, Indonesia and Japan to make true sustainable fabrics using sustainable manufacturing practices.

LENZING™

STSC sells Forest Based Fabrics (FSC) made from eucalyptus and birch wood pulp sourced from sustainable forests grown in Austria and Bavaria, with the yarn being produced by Lenzing™ and the fabrics milled in India to STSC's specifications with carefully selected Mills who follow sustainable practices including AZO-free plus GOTS dyes and state of the art effluent biowaste systems.

SWING TAGS, PR & MARKETING

As a registered wholesaler with Lenzing, STSC will supply you with swing tags for your garments and high res logos and information to use on your own PR and marketing. We highly recommend that you make this prominent given the alternative non-trademarked fabrics with the names of tencel, modal, lyocell and viscose, these are most likely to be sourced from non-sustainable forests causing mass deforestation and some using endangered forests as closely documented by canopyplanet.org

In addition STSC have carefully chosen our Mills to be of the highest environmental and ethical standards who capture and recycle their water and don't use toxic chemicals plus AZO-free dyes so we can then taken Lenzing's yarn and produce beautiful sustainable fabrics.

COLOUR.

Choose a colour from Pantone. Non-standard colours can take an extra 30 days to develop.

Colour retention. Colour pigments are deeply embedded into the fibres, which retain long-lasting colour vibrancy more than conventionally dyed fibres and are less prone to fade even after repeated washing.

The fiber has the certification of the EU Ecolabel label to the environmental excellence. Ecovero™ generates 50% lower emissions and less water use compared to a conventional viscose. (Higg MSI provided by the Sustainable Apparel Coalition).

FABRICS. Our fabrics are organic and Eco-friendly. The inks are 100% plant base, biodegradable and approved for babies by OEKO-TEX® Standard.





GLOBAL ORGANIC TEXTILES STANDARD.

To be certified organic, fabrics such as our organic cotton, must be grown and produced under stringent standards that relate to the use of synthetic fertilizers and pesticides. To be labelled organic, the fabric meets the international standards set for fibre production and processing by <u>GOTS</u> (Global Organic Textile Standard).

Client have the option to either purchase fabric that is not printed and plain griege fabric, or print to your own design, or have dyed through your own or our service. The printing or dyeing service is done through STSC's Consultancy Service.

These fabrics come from out Mill in India and are either plain or printed – **ECO-PRINTING IS 100% WATERLESS DIGITAL PRINTING.**

Our printer is designed to reduce waste in fabric, ink consumption and electricity making it an energy and material conscious printer. The printing is in-house and uses the innovative and eco-friendly NeoPigment™ digital printing technology created by Kornit. The revolutionary process uses zero water in the printing which includes no pretreatments, washing or steaming. Aside from being water free, the integrated process eliminates the need for external or additional chemical pre-treatments.

The inks are water-based NeoPigment[™] and are 100% free of heavy metals, formaldehyde and Alkylphenol Ethoxylates (APE), making them non-hazardous, non-toxic and biodegradable

To print your own design on the many of STSC fabrics the Steps to follow are:

- Purchase the Consultancy Fee to set up and manage the print job is AUD\$330 approx. EURO 194 / USD 218 / GBP 175
- STEPS Send a Job Order form so we can accurately formulate the Consultancy price according to your requirements, how many prints, etc.
- Request a Consultancy Contract
- Pay invoiced Consultancy fee ascertained after STSC sees your Job Order.
- STSC refine the Purchase Order re details of print job and fabric. 10 metre minimum (20m MOQ if Plain fabric with no printing)
- STSC to send samples of printed fabrics for you to see quality.
- Send high resolution TIFF files / Vector Files
- Finalise pricing, moq, specs, delivery, payment details, etc
- 30-50% Deposit paid to STSC/Mill for printed fabric.
- 3-5 metre print samples are sent to Client for approval or adjustment. Courier fees are additional.
- If adjustments are required STSC charge an additional per hour fee to make adjustments and order a new Production sample from the Mill.
- Once the client is satisfied, remaining payment is finalised along with courier fees and the fabric shipped by STSC.
