STSC are proud to be working with eco-sericulture specialist to produce our Peace Silk, plus to have been selected by Lenzing Austria to be one of their exclusive wholesalers to sell their new luxury product TENCEL™ LUXE. STSC have worked carefully to create these supply chains and is offering a wide range of luxury fabrics, plus fabrics that are entirely new blends. Exclusive to STSC, we have created a unique range of Luxe and Peace Silk blends that are possibly the world's most sustainable and ethical luxury fabrics.

PLANT SYLKS. STSC also have sylks that are so named as they are fabrics made from plant fibres and look and feel like silk, however Ive named them "Sylk" to create a departure. Scroll down to learn more about these gorgeous, biodegradeable and "wealth from waste" fabrics made from aloe vera, banana, rose petals, lotus, milk, corn, soya protein and more.



DYEING

STSC has a range of eco-dyeing options that include hand dyed with pure plant based dyes, bandhani tie and dye, shiboric, low-toxic dyes, GOTS dyes, batik design, etc.

PRINTING

STSC has a range of eco-printing options, primarily two in India and two in Sydney to be able to offer a range of prices, styles and MOQs. Printing techniques include low-toxic digital printing, water based digital printing, GOTS dyes screen printing, block printing, etc.

Dyeing and Printing on fabric is often costed through quotes following payment of a STSC Consulting Fee. See website for Consultancy information.

Dyeing and printing can take around 30-60 days depending on all the variables.

PEACE SILK AND SILK BLENDS.

We source our silk from India where it is known as Ahimsa Silk, Peace Silk, Non-violent Silk or Cruelty free silk. Central to our belief system, we are opposed to "regular" silk where the silk worm is boiled alive and toxic chemicals are used to de-gum the cocoon, our suppliers have created a modern form of rural cooperation where it's important to them that they treat the silk worms, themselves, their community and their environment with utmost care.

By working as a co-op, the production is cleverly decentralized to allow the silk farmers, spinners, weavers etc. to work directly from their own areas. The different units of cocoons, yarns and ready textiles are then connected and stored at a centralized headquarters.

THE PEOPLE. The co-op follows a corporate social responsibility platform, where sustainable utilisation of manpower, ecology and natural resources work together. The living standards of the project members are higher, where the weavers have a comfortable lifestyle and their children are attending local schools. The women in the group are able to adapt their new professional skills allowing for social and economic self-dependency.

THE ENVIRONMENT. There are zero pesticides or genetic sprays used on the leaves or host mulberry trees feeding the worms which often creates a double crop. To create biodiversity, they have cultivated rice and potato along with the mulberry host trees. Ecologically, the entire region appears significantly greener than previous times.

During the silk farming stage, where they rear silkworms to produce silk, this occurs mainly in free nature and in some cases, indoors. To keep silkworms safe from harmful insects or birds, large mosquito netting is attached to protect each tree where the silkworms live and breed. In some cases, a Bio-Spray may be used.

SERICULTURE / SILK FARMING. Once the cocoons are ready, they are placed indoors on a bamboo platform. In case of Tussar silk, the cocoons are hung vertically from the ceiling using jute strings. In approximately one week, silk butterflies (moths) hatch out themselves or in some cases the cocoons need to be pierced by well-trained staff to assist the moth. Each cocoon is checked that its empty and is then forwarded to the degumming department. That is why the silk is known as Peace silk.



PRODUCTION. The process of eliminating "Gum (sericin)" and impurities from raw silk is known as degumming of silk. This is done by adding natural bio soap in the hot boiling water. Occasionally hydrogen peroxide is used to make different shades 3 of silk yarn uniform.

CERTIFICATION by REACH & GOTS. In commercial "regular" silk, toxic metals such as Chromium, Barium, Lead, Iron or Sodium magnesium are used during the degumming process of 'silk- weighting' to make silk yarns heavier. These chemicals are not used or permitted in our production.

Four out of our twenty power looms have been upgraded with solar powered motors. Spinning and reeling is processed either manually or with solar machines. This makes 70% of our spinning and weaving operation zero-carbon. Packing and storing of the product is mainly done with jute bags or reclaimed cardboards. Transport of cocoons or ready yarns to weavers in different areas is done by public transport state roadways or Indian railway. Water usage is minimised in our production process with reclaiming used water by filtering the old used water. Residue from cocoon degumming is used as compost for agriculture.

LOCAL PRINTING - GOTS certified Eco-friendly zero impact digital printing.

We have 2 digital printing machines in our factory. Both are custom made printing system for peace organic silk. This German-Japanese combination is the best in sustainability. Inks are GOTS certified and of zero impact on nature and human skin. This system consumes very small amount of ink, electricity and water. Our printing floor is made with zero-waste facility. Waste water from printing is recycled/ reused for further use through in-house bio-ETP plant.

TIMEFRAME. Between 3 and 6 weeks. For dyeing and printing, after approval of lab dip, will be 3 to 4 weeks. MOQ 1 roll (45 to 49 meters). Prices may differ also regarding width. Offer 114cm or 140cm widths. Price in Australia \$

We especially love our unique Ayurvastra handloom organic cotton fabric plus Ahimsa Silk (Peace Silk) that is hand dyed using pure plant-based dyes plus infused with Ayurvedic medicinal plants, carrying the 5,000 year-old Indian natural medical practice known as Ayurveda, which is a sister science to yoga and meditation.

This handloom society was set up 29 years ago to give women weavers a fair wage. These artisans take great care in collecting up to 1200 herbal plants from nearby herbal forest, the Augestya Forests Range to put into the yarn.

In the case of the banana, aloe vera, milk, corn and soybean protein they are from 100% organic sources. These fabrics support STSC's Wealth from Waste philosophy. Banana Sylk is made from the banana plant's finest pseudo stem fibres, the softest part of the plant. It is organic, biodegradable, durable and picks up our eco GOTS dyes and pure plant dyes with outstanding colour depth to additionally minimise water waste. The fabric is silk-grade Banana Sylk made from 100% pure organic banana plant stem, is luxuriously soft, more breathable, durable, less water-consumptive and non-toxic; Banana Sylk is biodegradable plus more sustainable and eco than other natural fibre such as organic cotton, hemp and bamboo. This exceptional quality has been achieved through years of testing and using the latest advancements in fibre extraction methods.



Banana Sylk is fine and soft, similar in quality to silk-worm silk, however these natural textiles and care instructions should follow for Silk wash. Hand wash or cold gentle machine washed and do not require toxic dry-cleaning methods.
